## short instruction!

Cast on 61 stitches (31 for the back and 30 for the front of the leg), you can make a ribbing or any cuff you like. Work the pattern as charted and adjust the other stitches for the seed stitch (for example: row 1 starts with a knit stitch - be sure your last stitch before the pattern is a purl stitch, for rows 2 and 3 your last stitch before the pattern is a knit stitch, for rows 4 and 5 your last stitch before the pattern is a purl stitch... - the seed stitch is made over 2 rounds and then changed from knit 1/purl 1 to purl 1/knit 1 and vice versa for the next 2 rounds and so on). Sorry, it's difficult to describe but I hope it will be obvious when you start knitting.

You can work any heel you like, with seed stitch or not - it's absolutely up to you, same for the toe - work it as you like it.
